The first Primary election for Nebraska was held September 20th, 1907, Nebraska being among the first States in the Union to provide this method of nominating candidates to public office. The Primary Law has been amended from time to time, and will probably be subjected to change by the Legislatures of the next convening.

The Legislature of 1919 by the passage of House Roll 3223 revised the Primary Law by providing that State officers below the Governor should be nominated by State Conventions and at the same time the Bill extended the operation of the Primary Laws to cover the election of delegates to county conventions and precinct committeemen for county committees.

That part of the bill, however, which provided for nomination of State officers below the Governor by State Conventions was rendered inoperative by the filing of a petition to refer that part of the Bill to the people, and, by provision of the Referendum Law, the same will be referred to the electors at the general election, November 2, 1920. This had the effect of making the Primary ballot unusually long and the work of compilation of returns unusually difficult.

The information contained in this pamphlet will be valuable to those interested in the political activities of the State and, likewise, to those interested in statistical research.
