**Elected Candidates \*\*\*\***

#### Boone County

Boone County is part of State Board Education, Sixth District. The candidates for the fifth district were put on the ballot in error. Therefore, there were no returns for Terry Loschen and Pat Moore, candidates for the sixth district.

#### Douglas County

Twenty-nine voters were given ballots for the sixth Legislative district rather than the eighth Legislative district. Eric Will was elected over John Folsom in the eighth Legislative district by 982 votes. Pam Brown was elected over Tom Skutt, Jr. in the sixth Legislative district by 883 votes.

#### Frontier County

Frontier County is a part of Nebraska Public Power District, subdivision 6. The candidates, Bruce Gustafson and Geoffrey K. Bogle, were omitted from the ballot. 1,287 votes were cast at the general election in Frontier county. Bruce Gustafson was elected by a margin of 13,068 votes.

#### Nemaha County

The name of Gerald J. Royal, candidate at large for Nemaha Natural Resources District, was omitted from the ballot. The at large seat was uncontested so the omission did not affect the election of the candidate.

#### Platte County

Duane Munson, Dick Kamm, and Dave Mullin were elected along with Diane Sindelar in Educational Service Unit, number seven. Munson, Kamm, and Mullin are all residents of the city of Columbus. Pursuant to section 79-2203, only two of the elected members can reside in the city of Columbus. 79-2203. "The educational service unit board shall consist of one member from each county and four members at large, all of whom shall reside within the geographical boundaries of the educational service unit, but no more than two of the members at large shall be appointed or elected from the same county unless any one county within the educational service unit has a population in excess of one hundred fifty thousand inhabitants or the educational service unit consists of only one county..."

#### Scotts Bluff County

Mike Chrisman filed as a candidate for Educational Service Unit number thirteen in Scotts Bluff county. Mr. Chrisman is a resident of Scotts Bluff county, but is a registered voter in school district 21B, Morrill county. Pursuant to 79-2203(2) "Any local joint school district located in two or more counties shall be considered a part of the educational service unit in which the greater number of school-age children of such joint school district reside...Any qualified elector of any joint school district shall be eligible to hold office as the at-large representative if such elector resides within the geographical boundary of the school district comprising the educational service unit." Therefore, Mr. Chrisman was incorrectly filed as a candidate for ESU thirteen. He should have filed in ESU twelve.

Munson, Kahn, and Mullin are all residents of the city of Columbus. Pursuant to section 79-2203, only two of the elected members can reside in the County of Platte. "The educational service unit board shall consist of one member from each county and four members at large, all of whom shall reside within the geographical boundaries of the educational service unit, but no more than two of the members at large shall be appointed or elected from the same county unless any one county within the educational service unit has a population in excess of one hundred fifty thousand inhabitants or the educational service unit consists of only one county..."

The Canvassing Board at the meeting December 5, 1994 voted to issue the Certificate of Election to Eric Stewart, Schuyler, NE, Colfax County replacing Dave Mullin, the candidate receiving the fourth highest number of votes.
