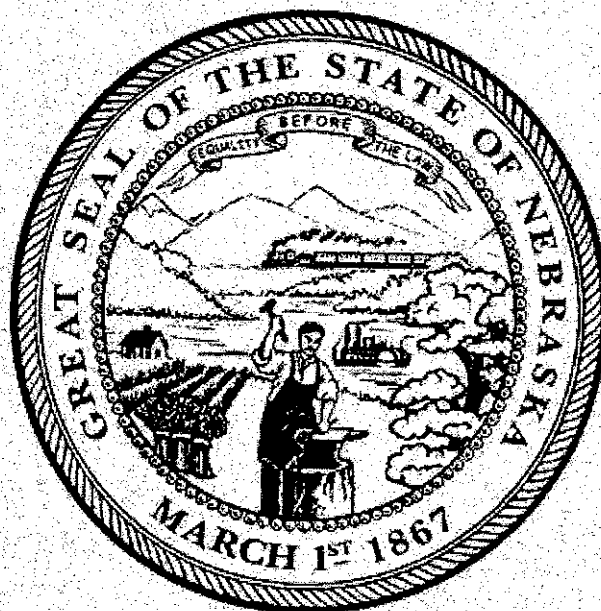

## **Reported Problems**

### **Adams County**

Equipment problems resulted in no ballots being counted until Thursday, November 7, 2002. Problems were caused by software and print errors. Once corrected ballots were counted normally with no problems. The problems do not appear to affect any vote totals.

### **Thurston County**

Poll workers in one precinct failed to provide voters a ballot containing judges standing for retention and the constitutional amendments. The poll workers discovered the error at about 3:30 PM on election day after approximately 142 voters had cast ballots. Due to the wide margins in the judge retention and constitutional amendment elections, the error had no impact on the outcome.

### **Furnas County**

Three specific problems were reported by local election officials and members of the public. These included a precinct election worker who took the cast ballots and supplies home election night and returned them to the courthouse the next morning. This apparently was a practice that had occurred over the last eight years. The second problem was a failure to include conditional/provisional voting materials in the precinct supplies. At least one precinct devised their own documents to accommodate voters. The third report was an apparent transcription or scrivener's error in one precinct. On a recount of a local race poll workers indicated that there was an error translating the vote total from tally marks to numeric form. This resulted in an additional 18 votes.
