Elected Candidates *****

Furnas County - page 21

Candidate Paul J. Liess, Sub. 2 of Central Community College was left off the ballot. The Sub. 2 seat was an uncontested seat so the omission of the name did not affect the election.

Furnas County - page 35

Candidates John Burkholder and Larry Janicek both received a high number of votes. The ballot was printed with (Vote for two). Only one was to be elected and the ballot should have read (Vote for one). Burkholder was elected by 167 votes. Ron Wunibald, manager of the NRD called several days after the election and said that he and one of the employees new the ballot was in error when they voted but did not call the error to anyone's attention.

Cedar County - page 18

The name of Judge Mark J. Fuhrman, District Court, 6th district was left off of the ballot. Judge Fuhrman was retained by a margin of 15,391 votes. The total number of voters voting was 6,161, so the omission of the name had no effect on his retention.

Fillmore County - pages 2 and 3

New residents voting for President (14). Votes received by Candidates (13). The county clerk reported one ballot rejected (overvoted).

Holt County - page 2

New residents voting for President (2). The Canvass Board did not keep the new residents' votes separated; added the two votes into the grand total for Holt County.

Lincoln County - pages 2 and 3

New residents voting for President (69). Votes received by Candidates (68). One ballot rejected by the Canvass Board.

Hall County - pages 2 and 3

New residents voting for President (222). Votes received by Canddiates (221). One ballot rejected by the Canvass Board.

Perkins County - page 2

New residents voting for President (3). Canvass Board did not keep new residents' votes separated; added the three votes into the grand total for Perkins county.
